

2010 IONIAN VILLAGE FAMILY CAMP

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

SATURDAY, JULY 17 CAMP BEGINS

Meet at Athens airport at 11:00 a.m. and depart for Ionian Village by bus. We will stop at the Corinthian Canal en route where there will be food available for purchase. When we arrive at camp, we will settle in and have a nice welcome dinner with some fun evening activities.

SUNDAY, JULY 18 CAMP DAY

We will stay at camp all day and get to know one another better. We will begin with Divine Liturgy and have a day of fun activities such as (arts and crafts, athletics, beach time, discussion groups, music, etc.).

MONDAY, JULY 19 TRAVEL TO ZAKYNTHOS

After breakfast, we will travel via ferry to the island of Zakynthos for the day. While there, we will venerate the relics of St. Dionysios. After that, families will have some free time on the island for exploration, returning to Ionian Village in time for dinner and night-time activities.

TUESDAY, JULY 20 TRAVEL TO OLYMPIA

In the morning we will journey to ancient Olympia—site of the first Olympics—for a half-day outing. After that, we will return to Ionian Village for lunch, rest, and activities.

WEDNESDAY, JULY 21 TRAVEL TO PATRAS

In the afternoon we will journey to Patras for a half day outing where we will venerate the relics of St. Andrew the First-Called Apostle. We will end the evening with dinner in the city.

THURSDAY, JULY 22 CAMP DAY

We will spend our last day on the Ionian Village grounds enjoying the beach and other activities the camp has to offer.

FRIDAY, JULY 23 TRAVEL TO ATHENS *(for the remaining trip Athens will be our home base)*

En route to Athens we will stop at the Monastery of Osios Loukas and have lunch in Delphi. Once we settle into our hotel in Athens (the Metropolitan) we will head out for dinner as a group.

SATURDAY, JULY 24 TRAVEL TO AEGINA

Today we will take the ferry to the island of Aegina where we will venerate the relics of St. Nektarios. Families will have some free time for lunch and to explore the island.

SUNDAY, JULY 25 TOUR ATHENS

Our day will begin with Divine Liturgy at one of the local churches. After brunch families are welcome to explore Athens on their own or can stay with the group. We will end our Family Camp with a Farewell Dinner on the rooftop of our hotel overlooking the city of Athens.

MONDAY, JULY 26 DEPART

Breakfast is available from the hotel that morning. The buses will be departing for the Athens airport promptly at 8:00 a.m.
